

## Sermon Downloading Instructions

If you have attempted to download the sermon as an mp3, and the browser starts playing the sermon instead, the most likely culprit is a software program called "Quicktime" that is installed on your PC computer. There are two ways to get around this: One, remove Quicktime from your computer (not necessarily recommended). Or two, download the Internet browser "Mozilla Firefox" at <http://www.mozilla.com/en-US/>

Once you've downloaded Mozilla, then download the add-on "Download Helper" at <http://www.downloadhelper.net> which will allow you to download media files that are playing through your browser, like this week's sermon.

Once that is all done, then come back to this website *using the Mozilla browser* and you will be able to download the sermon as an MP3 using the Download Helper add-on. It will be located to the left of the address bar of the browser and it's icon will have three spinning globes (blue, yellow and red). Click on the down arrow right next to it and then click on the file that ends in .mp3 and click the download option next to it. Then locate the file and put it on your MP3 player.
